### RESPECT LIFE - Fixing Health Care a Legislative Goal of U.S. Bishops:

In a recent letter to Congress, Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, Chairman of the U.S. Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities, said that the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) was "profoundly flawed in its treatment of abortion and conscience rights and that efforts to ensure our health care system truly serves the life, health and conscience of all will be a legislative goal of the Catholic bishops in the months to come." The US bishops are supporting the passage of corrective legislation. Rep. Joseph Pitts (R-PA) introduced legislation (H.R. 5111) to remedy PPACA's serious problems on abortion. This bill would prevent PPACA from requiring abortion coverage or paying for abortions. Please contact your U.S. Representative and ask him to support H.R. 5111.
