RESPECT LIFE - The Obama administration's HHS mandate has united Christians of all stripes - evangelical, historical Protestant, and Roman Catholic - as they close ranks behind a flurry of lawsuits filed to overturn the controversial measure and stall government interference in religion. Concerned Women for America President Penny Nance stated: "We are all Catholic now, and this is why--the religious community stands together in the belief that this contraception, chemical abortion, and sterilization mandate would force us to pay for something many of us believe is morally repugnant." The fact that Catholic religious institutions filed the lawsuits provided "more evidence that the healthcare law is extremely flawed in its bias for abortion and abortion-inducing drugs; this lawsuit is only the beginning as many Americans are deeply troubled by the largest expansion of abortion since *Roe v. Wade*." said Dr. Charmaine Yoest, President of Americans United for Life. All of the lawsuits cite concerns about religious liberty and undue government interference and make clear that the loss of freedom of conscience threatens all of our other freedoms.
