Violinist Bagus Wiswakarma and pianist Lisa Weiss, faculty members at the Opus Community Music School, will perform Franz Schubert's sunny Sonatina in D, Bela Bartok's fiery Romanian Folk Dances, and Cesar Franck's monumental Sonata in A. Dr. Weiss, Professor Emeritus of Music at Goucher College, will offer brief remarks on each work.



A native of Massachusetts, **Lisa Weiss** made her debut with the Boston Pops at seven, performing a Haydn concerto under the direction of Arthur Fiedler. She concertizes regularly as a soloist, chamber musician, and vocal accompanist. Of her NY debut, the New York Times' Wil Crutchfield called her "a musician worthy of attention and able to hold it." Lisa is a Professor of Music Emeritus at Goucher College. She teaches privately and at the Opus Community Music School, as well as at Goucher in an adjunct capacity. She received her B.A. from Harvard, M.M. from The Yale School of Music, and a D.M.A. from The Peabody Conservatory of Music, where she studied with Leon Fleisher.

A native of Indonesia, **Bagus Wiswakarma** studied violin at the Hochschule fuer Musik und Theater under Prof. Winfried Ruessmann. Additional pedagogical studies include the Amadeus Quartet, Brandis Quartet, Schleswig Holstein Music Festival in Europe and Asean Youth Music Workshop. Mr. Wiswakarma is a concert soloist and Founder/Director of the Chamber Music Series (Jakarta, Indonesia 1999 – 2006). He has also served as the Director of the Jakarta International Music School and Jakarta Philharmonia. Since 2008 he has been a faculty member of the Carroll County String Project (now OPUS Community Music School) and served as its Artistic Director until 2017.

A vibrant part of Carroll County since its founding in 2007, **Opus Community Music School** is a non-profit organization dedicated to enriching the community by providing affordable music lessons of the highest quality to students of every age, ability, and background.
